

Primary 1 Winter Activities

Below are some activities that can be completed in the case of a snow day/bad weather day. You do not have to complete all of the tasks and can choose the ones that interest you most. Activities do not have to be submitted to the teacher but you can if you wish.

Literacy

- Practise reading your favourite books at home.
- Create a new character for your favourite book.
- Draw a picture of your favourite part within a book.
- Re – design your books front cover.
- Re-tell your favourite stories by using the beginning, middle and end.
- Practise your sounds.
- Can you make 3 letter words with your sounds?
- Write 3 letter words using your sounds.
- Go on a sound hunt around your home or outside.

Numeracy

- Practise identifying numbers to 20.
- Practise writing numbers to 20.
- Practise your doubles and body doubles.
- Practise adding by adding your toys etc. Can you make up sums?
- Practise telling the time using o'clock and half past.
- Practise your days of the week and months of the year. Can you put them in order?
- Creating your own patterns using a variety of shapes, colours or numbers.
