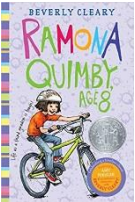




P4 Home Learning Choices set 1

Measure Think of different things we can measure. e.g. Length, volume, height, weight. See if you have a ruler, a measuring jug and scales and try out measuring different things. Make out a chart showing what it is you have measured and what the measurement was. Remember we must try very hard to be accurate when doing this.	Money Ask someone in your house if they have any coins in purse or wallet. Lay them out and write the value of each coin underneath. Now add them up – How much did they have? See if another family member has coins too and doing the same activity, find out who had the most money and by how much.	Dice roll rounding Choose a number of times to roll your dice. Roll it this number of times and add up the numbers you got. e.g. 6 2 Then round your answer to the nearest 10. =60 Do this activity 5 times.	Times tables cards. Write down some of the times tables you have learned at the side of a page. e.g. X4 X3 X5 X10 Then use a pack of cards and place a card beside each of your numbers. Answer the sums you have given yourself, clear the cards, then give yourself new sums by placing new cards beside your numbers.	Choose 5 numbers up to 100 Then see how many ways you can make these numbers. e.g. 16 That could be 15 + 1, 3 + 13 2 + 4 + 10 Count how many different ways you have managed.
