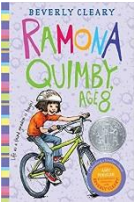




P5 Home Learning Choices set 1

Measure Think of different things we can measure. e.g. Length, volume, height, weight. See if you have a ruler, a measuring jug and scales and try out measuring different things. Make out a chart showing what it is you have measured and what the measurement was. Remember we must try very hard to be accurate when doing this.	Money Ask someone in your house if they have any money in purse or wallet. Lay out the coins and notes, writing the value of each. Now add them up – How much did they have? See if another family member has money too, and doing the same activity, find out who had the most money and by how much.	Dice roll rounding Roll your dice 3 times. Write down the numbers as you roll them. E.g. a 1 2 6 Now round this number to the nearest 10. =130 Do this activity 5 times. Then try to extend by throwing 4 times and round to the nearest 100.	Times tables cards. Write down some of the times tables you have learned at the side of a page. e.g. X4 X7 X5 X10 Then use a pack of cards and place a card beside each of your numbers. Answer the sums you have given yourself, clear the cards, then give yourself new sums by placing new cards beside your numbers.	Choose 5 numbers up to 100 Then see how many ways you can make these numbers. e.g. 16 That could be 15 + 1, 3 + 13 2 + 4 + 10 Count how many different ways you have managed. Feel free to challenge further by choosing numbers up to 1000
